

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Earl M. Nordgren and Ethel Nordgren of 18th and C St., Forest Grove, Oregon State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Gales Creek, a tributary of Tualatin River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 3/10ths of one cubic feet per second.

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation.

4. The point of diversion is located 1395 ft. S and 1210 ft. W from the corner of Section 1, T.1 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

being within the SE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 1, Tp. 1 S., R. 4 W., W.M., in the county of Washington.

5. The main pipe line to be 400 ft. in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 1, Tp. 1 S., R. 4 W., W.M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.
