

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, C. C. Corwin and Blanch L. Corwin of Route 1, Box 96, Ashland, Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is a spring, a tributary of Deep River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 2.53 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 100 ft. and 100 ft. from the corner of Section 30

Beginning at a point on the South line of Lot Six (6) in Block "A" of the Rogue River Valley Orchard Co's Orchard Tracts in Jackson County, Oregon, according to the official plat thereof, now of record, said point being North 89° 54' East 59.97 feet from the Southwest corner of said Lot 6; thence North 0° 04' West 134.0 feet; thence South 89° 32' West 399.81 feet to the West line of Lot 7 in said Block "A"; thence South along the West line of said Lot 7, 131.4 feet to the Southwest corner thereof; thence East, along the South line of said Lots 7 and 6, to the point of beginning;

ALSO, all of lots 8, 9, 10 and 11 in said Block "A" and all that portion of Carter Lane as vacated extending from the East line of said Lot 8, to the West line of said Lot 11;

ALSO, all that part of Block "B" of said Tracts, according as follows: Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10.

EXCEPTING therefrom a strip of land 20 feet wide, extending from the East line of said Block "B" to Jackson County, Oregon, by and through the right-of-way shown on Page 563, of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon, the Southern line of said road being as follows: Beginning at a point on the East line of Block "B", 20 feet from the intersection of the East line of Block "B" and the North westerly line of the county, as known and shown on said Block "B"; thence in a Southwesterly direction for a distance of 100 feet to the East line of Block "B"; thence North 89° 32' West 399.81 feet to the Southwest corner thereof; thence East, along the South line of said Lots 7 and 6, to the point of beginning;

ALSO, EXCEPTING therefrom all that portion of Block "B" lying between the East line of said Block "B" and the East line of Block "A";

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.53 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/12th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 16, 1951

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 16, 1951 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 16, 1951

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before August 16, 1951
