

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, R. L. Hamman of Route 2 Box 625 Roseburg State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is North Umpqua River, a tributary of Umpqua River. 2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 3.33 (1500 g.p.m.) cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation.

4. The point of diversion is located 198 ft. N and 165 ft. W from the corner of Sec 33-34.

being within the ANNE of Sec. 33, Tp. 26S R. 6W, W. M., in the county of Douglas. 5. The Pipe Line to be 2041' in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 of Sec. 35, Tp. 26S, R. 6W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam 0 feet, length on top 0 feet, length at bottom 0 feet; material to be used and character of construction NONE.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.581 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from North Umpqua River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 21, 1951

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 31, 1953 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1954

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1955
