

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, GERALD & DOROTHY HARRIS of Pt. 1 box 249, Philomath, ORE., do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is MARYS RIVER, a tributary of WILLAMETTE

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is IRRIGATION

4. The point of diversion is located N. 66° 27 1/2' E. 7.068 chains from the SW corner of the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec 30

Beginning at a 1" pipe, the legal subdivision corner which is on the section line 20.108 chains N. 88° 51' W. of the Northeast corner of Section 31, T. 11 S. R. 6 W. of the Will. Mer. in Benton County, Oregon; and running thence N. 0° 22' W. along the legal subdivision line 1.448 chains to the south line of the Southern Pacific Company's railroad property, which point is .018 of a chain S. 45° 53' E. of a stone, the southwest corner of said railroad depot grounds, thence along the south line of said grounds S. 45° 53' E. 4.982 chains and on a 15.689 chain radius curve to the left which long chord is S. 57° 18' E. 6.278 chains to a 2" shaft, thence S. 0° 39' W. 34.855 chains to a 3/4" bolt on the line west through the center of said section at a point 11.106 chains N. 88° 31' W. of the 1/4 section corner, thence N. 88° 31' W. along said line 8.903 chains to a 3/4" bolt the legal subdivision corner, thence N. 0° 38' E. along the subdivision line 40.033 chains to the place of beginning, containing 33.55 acres, excepting The County road along and on the north side which is 40 feet wide and contains .69 of an acre.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed .690 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Mary's River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 30, 1951

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 31, 1953 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1954

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1955
