

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Mr. E. L. Jamison and Mary A. Jamison, husband and wife of 213 South 4th Street, Nyasa, Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Owyhee River, a tributary of Snake River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 3 cubic feet per second, for a total area of 99.91 acres

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 547 ft. S. and 679 ft. East from the N.W. corner of S.W. 1/4 N.W. 1/4 Sec. 2 Township 21 South, Range 46 E.W.M.

being within the S.W. 1/4 N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 2, Tp. 21 South, R. 46 E. W. M., in the county of Malheur

5. The pipe line to be 100 feet in length, terminating in the S.W. 1/4 N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 2, Tp. 21 S., R. 46 E. W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed ~~111668~~ 3.00 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Owyhee River

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation (Supplemental)

This appropriation shall be limited to a total quantity, which, together with that received under other rights, will not exceed that which can be beneficially used,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is October 1, 1951

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 31, 1953 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1954

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1955
