

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Heyman-Campbell Farms, of Rt. 4, Box 164, Albany, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Willamette River, a tributary of Columbia River.

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1.7 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation.

4. The point of diversion is located ... ft. and ... ft. from the corner of Irrigation by means of portable pumping equipment from Willamette River anywhere along river within SW 1/4 of SW 1/4, SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of T11N, R4E, Section 2, Township 11 South, Range 4 West. (Reference monument set on the west line of and South 15.67 chains from the northwest corner of Section 11, T11S, R4E, S1/4.)

being within the ... of Sec. 2, T11S, R4E, S1/4.

No. 57 in said Township and Range; thence West along the North line of said Claim 26.5 chains to the West line of Section 11; thence North along the West line of said Section 15.26 chains to the South line of Tract 11 of Bryant's tracts; thence East along the South line of said Tract 21.22 chains to a point 6.50 chains West of the West line of the Survey Gordon D.L.C. No. 51 in said Township and Range; thence South 16.14 chains to a point 1.18 chains West and 0.30 chains East of the Northwest corner of the George Cline D.L.C. No. 84 in said Township and Range; thence West 6.713 chains to a point 0.879 chains West of the Northwest corner of Claim No. 57; thence North 1.038 chains to a point due North of the point of beginning; thence West 0.879 chains to the point of beginning, in Linn County, Oregon.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.672 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Willamette River

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is December 28, 1951

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 31, 1953 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1954

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1955
