This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,
SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to benefit of use
and shall not exceed 0.375 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream and
reservoir to be constructed under Application No. R-26380, Permit No. R-1308.

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 acre foot of one cubic foot per
second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be
further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet for each acre irrigated
during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir
to be constructed under Permit No. R-1308 ; provided further that the amount of
water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing
for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the manager state.

The priority date of this permit is November 19, 1951

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1953
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before
October 1, 1954

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before
October 1, 1955
