This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use of stored water only and shall not exceed ~~4 acre feet~~ ~~4000 ft³/day~~ ~~4000 ft³/day~~ measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a reservoir to be constructed under Application No. R-26808, Permit No. R-1322.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to a diversion of ~~23~~ ~~of 674 cubic foot per~~ ~~4000 ft³/day~~ acre feet or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 21, 1952

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1953 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1954

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1955
