

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, J. N. Winton, of Route 1, Box 115, Eagle Point, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Little Santa Creek, a tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1.41 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 397 ft. S. and 5 ft. E. from the corner of Section 6

being within the NW 1/4 of Sec. 6, T. 12 N., R. 1 E., W. M., in the county of Jackson

5. The main pipe line to be in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 of Sec. 6, T. 12 N., R. 1 E., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 3.21 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Little Falls Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of an acre foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1/4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; this permit is issued subject to the terms and conditions of a stipulation recorded on page 642-643, Vol. 3, Miscellaneous Records of the State Engineer, and by reference made a part hereof;

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the engineer

The priority date of this permit is December 12, 1951

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1953

thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1954

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1955
