



APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Leland E. Sprague and Kathryn Sprague, of Rt. 1, Box 196, Lebanon, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is South Santiam River, a tributary of Willamette River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is .5 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located ... ft. and ... ft. from the corner of Irrigation by means of portable pumping equipment from South Santiam River ... along river in SE 1/4 of NW 1/4, NE 1/4 of SW 1/4, NW 1/4 of SE 1/4, and SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of S. 2, T. 13 S., R. 1 W.W.M. (Reference monument set N. 26° 50' E. 2.18 chains from the southwest corner of the Southeast 1/4 of S. 2, T. 13 S., R. 1 W.)

Beginning on the right bank of the South Santiam River and on the North boundary line of and East 12.94 chs. distant from the N.W. corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 2, in Tp. 13, S.R.1 W. of the Will. Merd., in Linn County, Oregon; and from thence running East along the North boundary line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 2, 5.40 chs.; thence South 7.70 chs.; thence West 3.40 chs. to the right bank of said River; thence following the meanderings of the right bank of said River, down stream, in a Northerly direction, to the place of beginning, and containing 3.35 acres, more or less, in Linn County, Oregon, and also,

Beginning in the center of Section 2 in Tp. 13 S. R. 1 W. of the Will. Merd., Oregon, and running thence West, on the S. This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.494 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from South Santiam River

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from ~~direct flow~~ and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is February 26, 1952

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1953 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1954

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1955
