

APPLICANT, PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Eddie E. Schmeid, of Pt 1 Box 134 McMinn State of Oregon, do her

application for a permit to appropriate the water to be used for the following described public waters of the State of Oregon

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and name of corporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is So. Willametta River, a tributary of the Willametta River

Willametta River (Name of stream)

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to appropriate is 100 cubic feet per second

100 cubic feet per second for beneficial use

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 220 ft. S and 1810 ft. E from the NW corner of Isaiah M. John D.C. 81

being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 22, Tp. 4 S, R. 4 W, W. M., in the county of Yamhill

5. The main ditch, canal or pipe line to be constructed is 1000 feet in length, terminating in the smallest legal subdivision of Sec. 22, Tp. 4 S, R. 4 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

STATE OF OREGON,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.750 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from South Yamhill River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a rotation of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

...rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
