



APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, VINCENT H. BURDICK of Rural Box 174 Canton Oregon State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is UNNAMED (Name of stream), a tributary of MILL CREEK

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is ONE HALF cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is IRRIGATION (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located ft. and ft. from the corner of T1E N60°E 4480 FEET FROM SW CORNER SECT 35- AND N33°W 2670 FT FROM SE CORNER SECTION 35-T4S R3E

being within the NW 1/4 OF SE 1/4 of Sec 35- Tp 4S R 3E, W. M., in the county of CLATSOP

5. The PIPE LINE to be 3700 FT INCLUDING MAIN PIPE in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 OF SE 1/4 of Sec 35 Tp 4S R 3E W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, **SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS** and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.375 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 3, 1952

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1953 and shall be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before
