

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, T. J. Primus
of Rt. P. Box 710 Salem
State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, **SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS** and the following limitations and conditions:

The right hereto granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.463 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream, springs and Reservoir to be constructed under Application No. R-26921, Permit No. R- 1337.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit No. R- 1337,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 3, 1952

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1953 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1954

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1955
