



APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Carl L. Johnson (Name of applicant)

of Brookings (Residing address)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Shy Creek (Name of stream), a tributary of the Pacific Ocean

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.25 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 664.3 ft. S (N. or S.) and 1486.4 ft. E (E. or W.) from the corner of sections 25 and 26 (Section or subdivision)

being within the NE 1/4, SW 1/4 of Sec. 25, Tp. 36N, R. 14W, W. M., in the county of Curry

5. The portable pipeline to be in length, terminating in the NE 1/4, NW 1/4, SW 1/4 of Sec. 25, Tp. 36N, R. 14W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

PERMIT

I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Shy Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer

The priority date of this permit is March 10, 1952

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1953 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1954

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1955
