s right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use 0.23 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the er its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Mary's River The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 23 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.23 c.f.s., ____ and shall be subject to such relicionable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The priority date of this permit is March 21, 1952 .
