

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Lyle D. Goodell of Box 209 Rt 2 Hillsboro State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Tualatin River, a tributary of Willamette.

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.15 cfs cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation.

4. The point of diversion is located 2845 ft. N and 1561 ft. W from the SE corner of Sec. 10, T. 25, R. 2W, WM.

being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 10 Tp. 25 R. 2W, W.M., in the county of Washington.
