

STATE OF OREGON,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,
SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use
and shall not exceed 1.52 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Trask River.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per
or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to
a portion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during
the irrigation season of each year,

in a reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The permit is March 31, 1952.

It shall begin on or before August 29, 1952 and shall
be used with due diligence and be completed on or before

the date the proposed use shall be made on or before
