R. 1 W. and 1 E.; running thence south 78° 28' west 1635.06 feet to a stone; thence north 3° 08' east 925.52 feet to an iron pipe in the center of the County Road; thence north 13° 31' east 882.9 feet to an iron pipe in the center of the County Road; thence south 89° 03' west 1011.9 feet to a stake; thence south to the Willamette River; thence down stream with the meanders of said river to the Willamette Meridian; thence north on the said Willamette Meridian to the place of beginning; SAVE AND EXCEPT therefrom a certain tract of land conveyed by C. R. 1 W. of the W. M.; thence north 27.72 chains to a stake; thence north 89° 03' east 15.33 chains to a pipe in the center of the County Road; thence south 13° 30' west 13.37 chains following the center line of present travelled road to an iron pipe; thence south 4° west 8.65 chains along the center line of said road to an iron pipe; thence south 60° west 13.35 chains to the place of beginning. EXCEPTING therefrom the following: Beginning at an iron rod on the left bank of the Willamette river at the southwest corner of hereinbefore described tract and running north 1° 30' west following the westerly line of said tract and center line of E. A. PERMIT

STATE OF OREGON,

County of Marion,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Willamette River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer

The priority date of this permit is June 9, 1952

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 29, 1954 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1954

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1955
