No. 51 in T1S, R4W, W.M., and running thence S89°19'E along the north line of said claim 2096.5 feet to the NW corner of that tract of land conveyed to Martin and Lena Gerdes by deed as recorded in volume 181, page 577 of Washington County, Oregon Deed Records; thence S19°55'E on the monumented westerly line of said Gerdes tract 6.8 feet to a stone; thence continuing S19°55'E 297.7 feet to an iron on said monumented line at the true place of beginning of the herein described tract; thence from the true place of beginning S19°55'E on the monumented west line of said Gerdes tract 1129.1 feet to a point in the county road from which point a stone bears N19°30'W 39.0 feet, and from which point a stone designated "H" in County Survey bears S66°40'W 484.3 feet, S67°17'W 159.9 feet, and N18°02'W 30.0 feet; thence N66°40'E in said county road 213.9 feet to a point; thence N66°40'E in said road 274.6 feet to a point; thence N3°18'W in the center of a 40-foot wide deeded road 300.0 feet to a point; thence N11°08'W in said road 249.0 feet to a point; thence N24°05'W in said road 103.9 feet to a point; thence N2°06'E in said road 143.4 feet to a point; thence N61°52'W 48.4 feet to an iron; thence continuing N61°52'W 227.7 feet to an iron; thence N73°07'W 264.8 feet to an iron; thence S6°27'W 65.1 feet to an iron; thence N87°31'W 264.2 feet to the true place of beginning.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.312 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Gales Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 9, 1952

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 22, 1953 and shall hereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1954

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1955
