Beginning at an iron pipe 26.01 chains North and 30.50 feet South 89° and 53' East from the Southwest corner of said Claim, and running thence North 27' East 578.60 feet; thence South 89° and 33' East 3.24 chains; thence North 42.53 chains; thence North 88° and 20' East 15.41 chains to the West line of said Claim; thence North 8:26 chains to the Northwest corner of said Claim; thence East 36.90 chains to the Northeast corner of said Claim; thence South 1° East 1.06 chains; thence South 30° and 30' East along the East line of said Claim 30 chains; thence South 62° West 26.40 chains; thence South 6° East 21.73 chains to the Northeast corner of the 10.46 acre tract conveyed by E. STATE OF OREGON,

County of Marion,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.875 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Yamhill River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 30, 1950

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 29, 1953 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1954

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1955
