

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Elmer Barkus, of Astoria, Oregon, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Abiqua Creek, a tributary of Pradding River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 3500 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 110 ft. S and 2520 ft. W from the corner of Sec. 23 see statement of remarks

being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Lot 3 of Sec. 23 Tp. 76 S

R. 1 W W. M., in the county of Marion

5. The 4" pipe line to be 1300 ft in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 23, Tp. 6 S

R. 1 W W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

Property to which water is to be applied is a portion of that more explicitly described by the applicant as follows:
Beginning at a point in the center of a 33 foot road, said point being North 24.795 chains from the North boundary of Section 26 in township 6 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian and East 32.85 chains from the Northwest corner of said Section 26; thence North 20.38 chains to the North boundary of 358 acre tract of land deeded by Susan M. Davis to Knud A. Loe recorded in Marion County, Record of Deeds, Volume 81, page 384; thence East 16.34 chains along the North boundary of said 358 acre tract of land to the West boundary of the Samuel Allen D.L.C., thence South 27° 13' West 8.64 chains to a cast iron grate bar set for an angle corner of a tract of land deeded by Knud A. Loe to Paul Haugen as recorded in Vol. 134 Page 221 Marion County Records of Deeds; thence North 69° 31' West 5.59 chains to an iron pipe; thence South 78° 31' West 6.16 chains to the place of beginning, and containing 30.30 acre, more or less, all situated in Section 23, Township 6 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Marion County, State of Oregon.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.350 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Abiqua Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 6, 1952

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 29, 1953 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1954

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1955
