



APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Stephens Stothart, of Route 1, Box 72, Rogue River, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Evans Creek, a tributary of Rogue River.

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.30 c.f.s cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation.

4. The point of diversion is located 285 ft. S. and 1770 ft. W. from the E. corner of Section 11... to 1030 feet South and 2625 feet West from the East corner of Section 11.

being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 11 Tp. 35 S. R. 4 W., W. M., in the county of Jackson.

5. The pipe line to be 1000 in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 11 Tp. 35 S. R. 4 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam ... feet, length on top ... feet, length at bottom ... feet; material to be used and character of construction none - masonry directly from holes along Evans Creek.

(b) Description of headgate none.

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 3.5" centrifugal pump, driven by 15 H.P. electric motor - total lift 50 feet.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Evans Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 27, 1952

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 29, 1953 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1954

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1955
