



APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Victor Learned, Jr. of Claverdale State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed Creek, a tributary of Big Nestucca River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.015 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic Use plus the water used at barn.

4. The point of diversion is located 1028.0 ft. S. and 210.99 ft. W. from the N.E. corner of Section 30, Twp. 4 S., R. 10, W.W.M.

being within the N.W. 1/4 of N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 30, Tp. 4 S., R. 10, W.W.M., in the county of Tillamook.

5. The Pipe line to be approx. 2000.0 ft. in length, terminating in the S.W. 1/4 of S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 19, Tp. 4 S., R. 10, W.W.M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works--

6. (a) Height of dam 7 feet, length on top 6 feet, length at bottom 7 feet, material to be used and character of construction timber.

(b) Description of headgate One outlet, 1" Metal pipe at 2000 Connecting with 3/4" plastic pipe line.
