Property to which the water is to be applied is a portion of that more explicitly described by the applicant as follows:  
 Beginning at the southwest corner of Section 31 in township 9 south, Range 6 West of the Willamette Meridian in Polk County, Oregon; thence North 40 chains to the quarter section corner on the west of said Section 31; thence <sup>east</sup> 6 chains to the west boundary of the James C. Hall Donation Land Claim, notification No. 5077, Claim No. 57; thence south 9.54 chains to the southwest corner of said Claim 57; thence east 25.95 chains to the south southeast corner of Claim 57 on the west boundary of the Lucian Heath Donation Land Claim, Notification No. 5093, Claim No. 56; thence north 17.18 chains to the corner of Claim 57 and the northwest corner of Claim 56; thence east 18.50 chains to the center of the county road No. 965; thence along the road south 29 10' East 20.54 chains, south 40° 35' East 6.93 chains and south 57° 25' East 10.36 chains; thence south 70° 10' West 10.59 chains to the center of Ritner Creek; thence down said creek South 25° east 8.90 chains and south 35° east 8.65 chains to the south boundary of Section 31 at 7.75 chains west of the southeast corner of Section 31; Excepting there from the area in the county road of 4.90 acres, leaving a net area of 259.3 acres.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.675 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Clayton Creek and Ritner Creek, being 0.412 cfs from Clayton Creek and 0.463 cfs from Ritner Creek.

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system, as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 25, 1952 for 0.1 cfs from Clayton Creek January 8, 1952 for 0.312 cfs from Clayton Cr. and 0.463 cfs from Ritner Cr.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 28, 1953 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1954

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1955
