State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper State officer.

The appropriation for domestic supply shall be limited to one-tenth of one cubic foot per second.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.13 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is July 28, 1914.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before Sep 23, 1915 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1916

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct 1, 1917
