

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, John Raymond Minty, of P.O. Box 98, Hillsboro, Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Tualatin River, a tributary of Willamette

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1/10 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 1950' ft. E from the NW corner of Section 12 and at any point where river is bounded by property described herein

being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 & NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 12, Tp. 1 S, R. 2 W, W. M., in the county of WASHINGTON. The main ditch, canal or pipe line to be in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 & NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec 12, Tp. 1 S, R. 2 W, the proposed location being shown throughout in the accompanying plan.

**Legal Description of J. R. Minty Property**

**PARCEL 1:** Beginning at a post on the north line between the north and south halves of Section 12, Township 1 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian, 5 chains east of the west line of said section; thence south 2.95 chains to the center of the Tualatin river; thence down the center of said river and with the meanderings thereof to a point where said stream intersects the line between the north and south halves of said section 12; thence west on said line 25.46 chains to the place of beginning.

**PARCEL 2:** Beginning at the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of section 12, township 1 South, Range 3 West, of the Willamette Meridian, running thence east 5 chains; thence south 20 feet, thence west to the west line of the southwest quarter of section 12, thence north 20 feet to the place of beginning.

**PARCEL 3:** Beginning at the quarter section corner on the west side of section 12, in T. 1S., R. 3W., W.M., being the southwest corner of the Diedrich H. Willars land; running thence north along the west line of said section 12, 676.5 feet to a point on said section line; running thence east 10 feet, thence south parallel with the west line of said section 12, 676.5 feet to the south line of said Willars land; thence west 10 feet to the place of beginning.

**ALSO:** Beginning at the quarter section corner on the west side of section 12, T 1S., R 3W., W.M., and being the southwest corner of Diedrich H. Willars land running thence north along the west line of said section 676.5 feet to a point on said section line thence west 10 feet then south parallel with the west line of said section 12. 676.5 feet, thence east 10 feet to the place of beginning; but the east half of parcel 3 being subject to the right of way to be used by Thomas H. Perkins, Amanda J. Perkins and Herman S. Gruschke, their heirs and assigns for a road right of way.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same. SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Tualatin River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 17, 1952

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 31, 1953 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1954

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1954
