

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Ed O'Reilly of Amity, Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed stream, a tributary of Salt Creek, trib. of Unnamed stream, a tributary of Salt Creek, trib. of South Yamhill.

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.34 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation.

4. The point of diversion is located 1531.95 ft from the corner of section 34, #2, T11N, R4W, Yamhill Co., Oregon, thence 334 ft from the NE corner of section 34, #2, T11N, R4W, Yamhill Co., Oregon, #1 Dam.

being within the NW 1/4, SW 1/4 of Sec. 35, T11N, R4W, W.M., in the county of Yamhill.

PERMIT

STATE OF OREGON,

County of Marion,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.5 acre feet of stored water only and shall not exceed ... measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from 2 reservoirs to be constructed under Application No. R-26104, Permit No. R-1108.

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to a diversion of 2.5 acre feet or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre feet per year during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 27, 1951

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 31, 1954 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1955

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1956
