

## APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

## To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

## DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

## Diversion Works—

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.250 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream and reservoir to be constructed under Application No. R-27295, Permit No. R-1411.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit No. R-1411, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.250 c.f.s.,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 9, 1952

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 31, 1954 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1955.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1955.
