

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Norval and Grace Gott, of Rt. 1 Box 51C, Lebanon, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is South Santiam River, a tributary of Willanette River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is cubic feet per second.

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located N. 33° 12' E. 24.0 chains ft. and ft. from the S.W. corner of the John L. Ambler D.L.C. 57 in T. 12 S., R. 3 W., (Reference monument is a 2" pipe located N. 35° 12' E. 22.77 chains from the S.E. corner of the John L. Ambler D.L.C. 57, T. 12 S., R. 3 W.)

5. The pipe line to be is length to be in the W.M. in the county of Minn.

Mer. in Linn County, Oregon; and running thence East 30.00 ch.; thence South 37.71 ch.; thence West 10.00 ch.; thence North 9.00 ch.; thence West 20.00 ch. to the West line of said Cl.; thence North 28.71 chains to the place of beginning and containing 96 acres. Except beginning at a 2" axle on the West line of and due South 1175.0 feet from the Northwest corner of Claim 53; thence S.89°45'E. 596.18 feet; thence South 730.13 feet; thence N.89°48'W. 596.18 feet to a 1/2" pipe on the West line of Claim 53; thence North 730.65 feet to the place of beginning and containing 10 acres. Except beginning at the Southeast corner of the Southernmost projection of the tract described in deed (133-439), being 30.00 ch. East and 37.71 chains South of the Northwest corner of Claim 53; thence West 10.00 ch.; thence North 9.00 ch.; thence East 10.00 ch.; thence South 9.00 ch. to the place of beginning and containing 9.00 acres. This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.375 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from South Santiam River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 2, 1952

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 31, 1953 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1953

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1953
