

• APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT.

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Carl A. Hanson P.O. Box 146, of Wauna, County of Clatsop, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is West Creek, ALSO KNOWN AS McFARLANE CREEK - AT TYPHOLOIDE TOWNSHIP, a tributary of Columbia River.

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 020 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic.

4. The point of diversion is located 811° ft. S and 65° ft. W from the 1/2 sec corner of bet sec 26 + 35 T8N R6W W.M.

being within the NW 1/4 - NW 1/4 of Sec. 35, T8N, R6W, W. M., in the county of Clatsop.

5. The Pipe line to be 345 ft in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 - NW 1/4 of Sec. 35, T8N, R6W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.
