

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Edward M. Esau, of R.R. 2, Box 244, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that owned by the applicant as follows:

Parcel 1: A tract of land situated partly in the Southeast quarter and partly in Government lot 7 of Section 16, Township 36 South Range 6 West of the Willamette Meridian, described as follows: Beginning at a point 44 rods West of the Southeast corner of the Southeast quarter of said Section and running thence North on the line between the lands formerly owned by C. H. Garner and C. N. Gilman, a distance of 30 feet; thence West a distance of 719.4 feet, more or less, to the line of that parcel of land conveyed to A. N. Hulbert by deed recorded in book 17 at page 227; thence South 90 feet; thence East a distance of 719.4 feet, more or less to the point of beginning.

Parcel 2. A part of Government lot 7, Section 16, Township 36 South Range 6 West of the Willamette Meridian, described as follows: A parcel of land for roadway described as beginning at the Northeast corner of Parcel 1, and run thence North 1200 feet, more or less to the center of the present county road; thence East 1 rod; thence South 100 feet, more or less to the North line of the tract first described; thence East 1 rod to the point of beginning.

Parcel 3: A part of Government lot 2, Section 11, Township 36 South Range 6 West of the Willamette Meridian, described as follows: Beginning at the Northeast corner of said lot and run thence West 100 feet; thence South parallel with the East line of lot 2 to the meander line of Rogue River; thence East along the meander line of Rogue River to the Northeast corner of said lot; thence North to the point of beginning.

Parcel 4: Government lot 1, Section 11, Township 36 South Range 6 West of the Willamette Meridian.

Parcel 5: The West 240 feet of Government lot 6, Section 11, Township 36 South Range 6 West of the Willamette Meridian, all being in the County of Josephine State of Oregon.
