

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Wayne B. Robertson, (Name of applicant)

of Multnomah County, Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Alder Creek (Name of stream)

a tributary of Chickahominy

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 10 gal per min (If waters to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic Use (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

And irrigate small garden + lawn. 1/2 acre

4. The point of diversion is located ft. and 4.6 ft. East from the corner of S.R.C. Monument 1/4 S 6, N.W. cor. Lot 7, Sec 6 (N. or S.) (E. or W.) (Section or subdivision)

in length, terminating in the Lot 3 of Sec. 6, Tp. 18 S, R. 7 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam 16 ft feet, length on top feet, length at bottom

feet; material to be used and character of construction (Loose rock, concrete masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

Water will be moved in pipe line by gravity (Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.)

\*\*Application for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Alder Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic including 1/2 acre lawn and garden for each family

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is December 2, 1952

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1954 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1955

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1956
