

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Alfred G. Hartley and Leona Hartley

of Cove, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed spring on NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 15, Tp. 3 S.R. 40 E.W.M., a tributary of

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.1 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic supply

4. The point of diversion is located 545 ft. E. and 103 ft. N from the S.W. corner of NE 1/4 of NE 1/4, Sec. 15, Tp. 3 S.R. 40 E.W.M.

being within the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 15, Tp. 3 South R. 40 East W. M., in the county of Union

5. The pipe line to be 1800 feet in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 15, Tp. 3 S.R. 40 East W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unmasked spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is December 8, 1952

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1954 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1955

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1956
