

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Ray DeLoren, of Route #5, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an unnamed drainage ditch which is a tributary of McKay Creek and McKay Creek, a tributary of Dairy Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.375 cubic feet per second from unnamed drainage ditch and 0.575 c.f.s. from McKay Creek

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located ft. and ft. from the corner of

Pt. of Diversion "A" is S5°18'W 5096.7 feet from the northeast corner of Section 30, T2N, R2W, W.M.

Pt. of Diversion "B" is S1°25'E 5037.3 feet from the northeast corner of Section 30, T2N, R2 W, W.M. (Portable pumping from drainage ditch)

being within the "A" is in SE1/4 of Sec. 30, Tp. 2N, R. 2W, W. M., in the county of Washington. Diversion pt. "B" is 1/8 SW1/4 of Sec. 29, T2N, R2W, W.M., Wash. County, Oregon. The pipeline to be 3.100 ft

5. The pipeline in length, terminating in the SW1/4 of Sec. 29, Tp. 2N, R. 2W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

Beginning at a stone in County Road A-110, East 1320 feet more or less and S18°49'E 266.8 feet from the northwest corner of the Eli Davis D.L.C. #42 in Section 30, T2N, R2W, W.M., Washington County Oregon; thence N85°43'E 193.9 feet to a point in County Road #50; thence in said County Road #50 S68°30'E 283 feet to a stone; thence S7°45'W 667 feet to a stone; thence N75°16'W 565.9 feet to a stone in County Road No. A-110; thence in the said County Road N30°01'E 477.6 feet to a stone; thence N16°49'W 200.8 feet to the place of beginning.

Parcel 2. Being a part of the Eli Davis D.L.C. in Section 30, T2N, R2W, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the northwest corner of said Davis D.L.C. in said Township and Range; running thence east 1320 feet, more or less, to the county road; thence in the present traveled road S18°49'E 465 feet; thence S29°01'W 477.6 feet to a point in the center of the county road for a beginning point of the land to be described. This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.949 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed drainage ditch and McKay Creek, being 0.374 cfs from drainage ditch and 0.575 cfs from McKay Creek.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is February 11, 1953

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 21, 1954 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1955.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1956.
