

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Otto Debrick, of Gen. Delivery, Willamina, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Mill Creek, a tributary of South Fork Yamhill River.

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.36 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation.

4. The point of diversion is located 1100 ft. N and 160 ft. E from the SW corner of Section 16, T65, R6 W.W.M. (System used by Dan O. Blair, Permit # 20357 using pump & diversion described in that permit).

being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 16, Tp. 65, R. 6 W., W. M., in the county of Polk.

5. The Pipe Line to be 1700 in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 17, Tp. 65, R. 6 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map and in NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec 16, T65, R6 W.W.M.

Beginning at a point in the center of the County Road leading from Shell to Sheridan which point is the northeast corner of Lot 2 and running thence west 36.75 chains to the center of Mill Creek; thence north 9°20' east down the center of Mill Creek 2.60 chains; thence north 54° 30' east down the center of Mill Creek 7.00 chains; thence north 26° east 2.00 chains to an iron pipe on the west bank of said creek; thence east 27.79 chains to the center of said County Road and thence south 14° 30' east along the center of said road 8.80 chains to the place of the beginning, containing 26½ acres more or less.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.360 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Will Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.360 c.f.s.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 16, 1953

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 21, 1954 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1955

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1956
