

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Harry Bainbridge (Name of applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

Property upon which water is to be applied is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

The Donation Land Claim of Elisha Williamson Number 48 being parts of Sections 12 and 13 in Township 25 South of Range 6 West of the Willamette Meridian, excepting therefrom the following: Commencing at a point 27 chs. and 12 1/2 links North of S W corner of the Elisha Williamson Donation Land Claim in Section 13 tp 25 S of R 6 West, running thence East 14 rods, thence North 40 rods, thence West 14 rods, thence South 40 rods, along the West boundary of said Elisha Williamson claim to the place of beginning, in Douglas County, Oregon, and containing 3 1/2 acres more or less. Also Excepting: Beginning at the extreme Northwest corner of the Elisha Williamson Donation Land Claim of Section numbered twelve (12) in Township twenty-five (25) South of Range Six (6) West, Douglas County, State of Oregon, running thence South ten (10) rods, thence East nineteen (19) rods to the County road, leading to Oakland, Oregon, thence in a Northeasterly direction meandering along said County road, thirteen rods (13) and ten (10) feet, thence West twenty-five (25) rods to the place of beginning, and containing one and the fractional part of an acre.

Also, excepting beginning at a point 18 rods and 43 links North and 15 chs. and 26 lks. East of the SW 1/4 of Section 12 Tp. 25 S of R 6 West of the line between the J. R. Dodge and Elisha Williamson Donation Claim, running thence North on said line 32 rods, thence East 28 rods to the County road leading to Oakland, Oregon, and being a roadway 50 feet in width all off from the Elisha Williamson Donation Land Claim. Also Excepting land described in that certain deed given by Helen Margaret Lawrence, et al, to George Trumbo and Delia Trumbo husband and wife, said deed being recorded at page 205 of Volume 100, Deed Records of Douglas County, Oregon. together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and also all our estate, right, title and interest in and to the same, including dower and claim of dower.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.425 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Galapooia Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 21, 1953

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 21, 1954 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 55 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 56.
