PERMIT

STATE OF OREGON,

County of Marion,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,
SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following Limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use
and shall not exceed 0.031 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unnamed stream.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per
second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of
not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation
season of each year, and shall be still further limited to a total diversion of not
to exceed 200,000 gallons per irrigation season,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the county engineer.

The priority date of this permit is March 16, 1953

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 1, 1953
therefore being given a reasonable time limit for completion.

Continuous application of the water to the land and all other uses

shall cease by August 21st, 1953.
