PERMIT

STATE OF OREGON,

County of Marion,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.031 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unnamed stream.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be still further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 200,000 gallons per irrigation season,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system, as may be ordered by the court.

The priority date of this permit is March 26, 1953

Actual construction work shall be begun on or before August 1, 1953

Therefore the permittee shall cause the same to be completed by August 1, 1953

Complete application of the water to the land shall be made by August 1, 1953
