

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, William H. Bishop (Name of applicant) of Route 2, Box 277, Central Point (Mailing address) State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is #1 drain ditch, #2 drain ditch, and slough, a tributary of Roxue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.36 c.f.s. cubic feet per second. being 0.20 c.f.s. from #1 Drain Ditch, 0.11 c.f.s. from #2 drain ditch, and 0.05 c.f.s. from slough. Irrigation.

- #1 Diversion is located 195' N. and 410' W. from the NE corner of Section 15, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 10, Township 36 South, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian.
#2 Diversion is located 150' N. and 240' W. from the NE corner of Section 15, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 10, Township 36 S., Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian.
#3 Diversion is located 1340' S. and 410' W. from the NE corner of Section 15, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 15, Township 36 S., Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian.
#4 Diversion is located 1300' S. and 240' W. from the NE corner of Section 15, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 15, Township 36 S., Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian.
#5 Diversion is located 745' N. and 410' W. from the E 1/2 corner of Sec. 15, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 15, Township 36 South, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian.
#6 Diversion is located 720' N. and 240' W. from the E 1/2 corner of Section 15, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 15, Township 36 S., Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian. All in Jackson County

5. The pipeline to be 920 feet in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 15 Tp. 36 S. R. 2 W. W. M. the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works--
6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction none - pumping from natural holes in drain ditches and slough.
(b) Description of headgate Water regulated by means of cut-off valve on pipeline near pump.
(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 2.0" centrifugal pump, powered by 3.0 H.P. gasoline engine -- Total lift 12.0 feet.

Beginning at a point 45 rods west of the east boundary of the lands described in Volume 11, at page 12 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon, and running thence west 12½ rods; thence south to the Rogue River; thence up Rogue River to a point 45 rods west of the east boundary of the lands described in said volume and page, and thence north to the place of beginning on the north boundary of said lands, as said premises are described in Volume 210, at page 150 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon.

Description: As copied from a Warranty Deed recorded in Vol. 202, Page 630, of the Jackson County Deed Records, Courthouse, Medford, Oregon.

Beginning at a point 35 rods west of the east boundary of the lands described in Volume 11, at page 12 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon, and running thence west on the north boundary of said lands 10 rods; thence south to Rogue River; thence up Rogue River to a point 35 rods west of the East boundary of said lands described in said volume and page; thence north to the beginning point on the north boundary of said lands.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.360 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from #1 Drain Ditch, #2 Drain Ditch & unnamed slough, being 0.20 cfs. from #1 Drain Ditch, 0.11 cfs. from #2 Drain Ditch & 0.05 cfs. from unnamed slough.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 29, 1953

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 21, 1954 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1955

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1956
