This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed1.00..... cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, fromwaste.....

The use to which this water is to be applied isirrigation.....

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to1/20..... of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion, and shall not carry within the right to compel the continuance of the waste water; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitations allowed herein,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit isMay 25, 1953.....

Actual construction work shall begin on or beforeAugust 21, 1954..... and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1955.....

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1956.....
