State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Intermittent un-named storm water (Name of stream) drainageway, a tributary of Luckiamute river and Lewis Farm Pond #1

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.35 cubic feet per second. including allowance for evaporation (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

Remarks: Stock Water Facilities.

One inch galvanized pipe approximately 60 feet in length runs from the inside bottom of the pond in a northward slope to a point approximately 20 feet W of the pipe driven in the top of the dam as a reference point and marked on the map. The upper end is laid in drain tile on a grade. The lower end has brass hose with brass couplings on the present market. In that ring troughs are installed to catch hose of the rubber or plastic variety and prevent the hose from being pulled in several places and be as long as the water hose out.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.35 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream and Lewis Farm Pond No. 1 to be constructed under Application No. E-27745, Permit No. R-1515.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation of not to exceed 2 acres, stock and fish culture, being 0.025 cfs for irrigation, 0.01 cfs for stock and 0.315 cfs for fish culture

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit No. R-1515,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 30, 1953

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 20, 1954 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1955

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1955
