

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Coquille Plywood Inc., of Coquille, Oregon, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation May 1951.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Coquille River and Reservoir, a tributary of Pacific Ocean

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 200/100 cubic feet per second.

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is manufacturing

4. The point of diversion is located 839.0 ft. S. and 1625.0 ft. E. from the N. E. corner of Lot 7, Section 2, T. 28 S., R. 13 W., M. 1. One inch pipe post for reference stands 1653.4 ft. west and 720.1 south of the same point.

being within the Lot 8 of Sec. 2, Tp. 28 S., R. 13 W., W. M., in the county of COOS

5. The pipe line to be 880 feet in length, terminating in the Lot 7 of Sec. 2, Tp. 28 S., R. 13 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam none feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction

(b) Description of headgate

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 6 inch centrifugal pump lifting water 30 ft. for reservoir and 188.0 ft. into concrete tank of 1,404,000 gals capacity for fire protection. Pump powered by 30 horse power electric motor.

\*A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated. \*\*Application for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission.



Description of the land of Coquille Plywood, Inc. accompanying application to appropriate water.

A portion of that certain parcel of land lying and being within Lot 6, Section 2 in Township 28, South of Range 13, West of the Willamette Meridian, and the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 35, in Township 27, South of Range 13, West as described in a deed from Albert A. Crouch, a widower, to the said John A. Martin and Rosa M. Martin, and recorded March 16, 1923 in Book 89 at page 177 thereof of the Records of Deeds of Coos County, Oregon, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the quarter section corner on the North boundary of Section 2, Township 28, South of Range 13, West of the Willamette Meridian, Coos County, Oregon, and running thence South along the quarter section line 524.04 feet, more or less, to the North boundary line of the right of way of the Southern Pacific Railroad; thence approximately north  $84^{\circ} 30'$  East along said railroad right of way 415.0 feet, more or less, to the center of a drain ditch; thence along center of said drain ditch up stream as follows: North  $34^{\circ} 35'$  West 80.0 feet; thence North  $9^{\circ} 35'$  West 85.0 feet; thence North  $16^{\circ} 22'$  East 50.0 feet; thence North  $7^{\circ} 30'$  East along center of said ditch a distance of 702.0 feet, more or less, to the South end of dike; thence East 8 feet to the center of said dike; thence North  $7^{\circ} 30'$  East along center of dike which is regarded as the dividing line between the land being described on the West and the land on the East which is owned by Raymond S. Linn and Anna R. Ziegler, a distance of 663 feet to the foot of the hill, at the Southeast corner of a 40 foot roadway; thence North  $3^{\circ} 35'$  East 247.5 feet along the East boundary of said 40 foot roadway to the Northeast corner of said roadway on the South boundary of U. S. Highway No. 101 to an iron pipe 2 inches in diameter driven in the ground at a point South  $3^{\circ} 35'$  West 26.5 feet from a gate post that is described in the deed from Albert A. Crouch to John A. Martin and Rosa M. Martin as being located at the West end of a gateway, and on the Southerly line of the Coquille-Marshfield State Highway. From the 2 inch iron pipe on the present South boundary of what is now U. S. Highway No. 101 as now being constructed, run South  $67^{\circ} 30'$  West 40 feet along South boundary of said U. S. Highway No. 101 to the Northwest corner of said 40 foot roadway; thence South  $3^{\circ} 35'$  West 256.0 feet to the Southwest corner of said 40 foot roadway; thence South  $53^{\circ} 30'$  West 196.5 feet along or near highwater line; thence South  $59^{\circ} 37'$  West along high water line a distance of 252.6 feet; thence North  $79^{\circ} 23'$  West 87.0 feet; thence North  $7^{\circ} 00'$  East 120.0 feet, more or less, to the South boundary of Highway No. 101; thence approximately South  $45^{\circ} 00'$  West 130.0 feet, more or less, to the quarter section line running North and South through the center of Section 35, Township 27, South of Range 13, West of the Willamette Meridian; thence South along said quarter section line a distance of 868.2 feet to the place of beginning, containing 14.9 acres of bottom and 0.34 acres of hill land, making a total of 15.23 acres. also

Beginning at the quarter section corner on North boundary of Section 2, Township 28 South, Range 13 West of the Willamette Meridian, Coos County, Oregon, and run thence North  $89^{\circ} 47'$  West 634.62 feet along township line to a cedar post marked C.S.; thence South  $3^{\circ} 29'$  East 40.47 feet along foot of hill; thence South  $47^{\circ} 49'$  West 214 feet along foot of hill; thence South  $63^{\circ} 09'$  West 41.60 feet along foot of hill; thence South  $46^{\circ} 24'$  West 219 feet along foot of hill; thence North  $89^{\circ} 47'$  West parallel with township line 800 feet, more or less, to West line of County Road; thence along West line of County Road as follows:

South 44° 47' West 160 feet; thence South 22° 26' West 234.6 feet; thence South 13° 15' West 176.75 feet, more or less to North boundary of the Coos Bay, Roseburg and Eastern Railroad (now Southern Pacific Company) right of way; thence in a Northeasterly direction along said right of way 2075 feet, more or less, to the quarter section line running North and South through the center of Section 2; thence North 524.04 feet, more or less, along said quarter section line to the place of beginning, containing 20.66 acres of land, more or less, there being 13.86' acres of bottom land and 6.80 acres of hill land, also.

Beginning at the quarter section corner on the township line of the North boundary of Section 2, Township 28, South of Range 13, West of the Willamette Meridian and the South boundary of Section 35 in Township 27, South of Range 13, West of the Willamette Meridian, Coos County, Oregon; thence running as follows: North along the quarter section line 736.4 feet, more or less, to the Southeast corner of a waste disposal area now under option to the Oregon State Highway Department from Dal M. King; thence approximately South 38° 30' West 57.0 feet along said waste area boundary; thence South 53° 00' West 42 feet along said boundary; thence South 58° 00' West 80.0 feet along said waste area; thence South 64° 30' West 114.3 feet, more or less, along said waste area boundary to the Southwest corner thereof; thence South 1° 11' West 82.0 feet along high water line; thence South 34° 16' West 175.3 feet along ~~water~~ high water line; thence South 14° 06' West 103.3 feet along high water line; thence South 36° 18' West 166.7 feet; thence South 52° 05' West 161.5 feet, more or less, to the township line on the South boundary of Section 35 and North boundary of Section 2 as described above; thence South 89° 47' East 592.0 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning, containing 5.46 acres of land, more or less. Granting also the right and privilege to the grantee and its assigns to allow the water level of the pond to seek a level to the high water line even though the land covered is not described herein, also.

Parcel 1: Beginning where the South boundary of U. S. Highway 101 intersects the quarter section line running North and South through Section 35, Township 27 South of Range 13 West of the Willamette Meridian, Coos County, Oregon; running thence North 45° 00' East 130 feet; thence South 7° 00' West 120 feet to the place of beginning of the land hereby conveyed; thence South 79° 23' East 47 feet; thence North 30° 35' West for a distance of 20 feet; thence Southwesterly 70 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning.

Parcel 2: Beginning at the most northerly corner of Parcel 1 hereinbefore described; running thence approximately North 58° 30' East parallel to and 20 feet distance from the northerly boundary of the parcel of land heretofore conveyed by grantors to grantee by deed recorded in Book 210, Page 4, Deed Records of Coos County, Oregon, to the westerly boundary of the 40 foot roadway in said deed described; thence South 3° 35' West to the Southwest corner of said 40 foot roadway; thence South 58° 30' West 196.5 feet, thence South 59° 37' West 232.5 feet; thence North 30° 35' West for a distance of 20 feet to the place of beginning.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from the Coquille River and reservoir to be constructed under Application No. R-26534, Permit No. R-1533

The use to which this water is to be applied is manufacturing

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is October 2, 1951

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 24, 1954 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1955

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1952
