APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, FRANK FISHER, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is TUALITHAN RIVER, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.125 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is IRRIGATION

4. The point of diversion is located 2145 ft. N and 553 ft. W from the S.E. corner of SECTION 10 - 1/4 Sec. 10 NE 1/4 of 8 E 1/4

being within the Sec. 4 & No. 8 of Sec. 10 Tp. 2 S R. 2 W, W. M., in the county of WASHINGTON

5. The PIPE LINE to be 1200 FT. in length, terminating in the of Sec. 10 Tp. 2 S R. 2 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

PERMIT

STATE OF OREGON

Department of Geology

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO ALL RIGHTS RESERVED and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.110 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from the Tualatin River.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 6, 1953.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 24, 1954 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1955.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1956.
