

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Roberta Harrison of Route 1, Box 344 Gold Hill, Oregon do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Brushy Gulch, a tributary of Left Fork Foots Creek, a tributary of Foots Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.15 c.f.s. cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation and domestic

4. The point of diversion is located 495 ft. N. and 1420 ft. E. from the E. corner of Section 12, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 7, T. 37 S., R. 3 W., W.M. - #2 diversion is located 395' N. and 100' W. from the E. corner of Section 12.

being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 12, Tp. 37 S., R. 4 W., W.M., in the county of Jackson

5. The main ditch and pipe line to be approximately 3400 feet in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 12, Tp. 37 S., R. 4 W., W.M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

Both - 6. (a) Height of dam 3.0 feet, length on top 8.0 feet, length at bottom 6.0 feet; material to be used and character of construction both diversion dams to be constructed of logs, rock, and dirt.

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description all gravity system.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.145 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Brushy Gulch

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and domestic, being 0.125 cfs for irrigation and 0.02 cfs for domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 2, 1953

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 24, 1954 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1955

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1955
