

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Jack Graf of Rt 3 Box 186 Tillamook Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed stream, a tributary of Tillamook River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.5 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Fish Culture, Domestic use

4. The point of diversion is located 740 ft. S and 12 ft. W from the corner of NE 1/4 of Sec. 29

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary) being within the NE 1/4 Sec. 29, Tp. 2 S R. 9 W, W. M., in the county of Tillamook

5. The Main ditch, canal or pipe line to be in length, terminating in the of Sec. 29, Tp. 2 S R. 9 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

The ponds will be in series and about 15 ft long by 10 ft wide by 3 ft deep. Because of the small amount of water impounded, it is felt that filling a reservoir application is unnecessary.

PERMIT

I hereby certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unnamed stream

The use to which this water is to be applied is fish culture

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 25, 1951

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 22, 1955 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1955

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1956
