

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Theodore Davm, of Polk Co., Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation None

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Spring Valley Creek, a tributary of Willamette River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 3/8 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 1050 ft. N and 80 ft. W from the SE corner of Sec. 8

being within the SE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 8, Tp. 6 S, R. 3 W, W. M., in the county of Polk

Property on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

Beginning at the southwest corner of the Donation Land Claim Numbered 57, Notification Number 281, of A. N. Swift and wife, in Township 6 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian in Polk County, State of Oregon; thence North 40 chains to the northwest corner of said claim; thence east on the north line of said claim 27.50 chains to Ben. Windsor's corner; thence south 23°45' West 21.75 chains along Windsor's west line; thence east along Windsor's south line 23 chains to the Section line; thence south 1.25 chains along Windsor's line; thence east 8 chains along Windsor's line; thence South 14° West 19.32 chains to the south line of said Swift claim; thence west 50.70 chains to the place of beginning, containing 154 acres of land more or less. Being the same premises, conveyed unto Marian K. Stratton by Quit Claim Deed of David V. Stratton, dated the 29th day of March, 1920, and recorded in the office of the County Clerk of Polk County State of Oregon, on the 6th day of April, 1920, at page 181, book 72, of Deed Records of said County. Property to be conveyed being all of the above tract which lies East of the State Highway as described in that certain deed recorded in Volume 98 at page 315 thereof, dated May 14, 1935 filed December 12, 1935, Deed Records of Polk County, Oregon.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.375 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Spring Valley Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 3, 1953

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 22, 1955 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1955

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1956
