following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Pudding River (Name of stream)
a tributary of Willamette River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.25

Stravens et ux by deed recorded in Volume 232, Page 273, Deed Records for Marion County, Oregon; thence South 87° 40' West 150.00 feet to the most Easterly Southeast corner of the tract conveyed to Joseph C. This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.218 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Pudding River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 12, 1954

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 30, 1955 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1956.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1957.
