

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, N. Vilas Jackson & Charles B. Jackson of 224 13th St., Hood River, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is two unnamed springs, property of the Oregon State Highway Dept., Salem, Ore., a tributary of

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.01 cubic feet per second. combined flow

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic purposes.

4. The point of diversion is located two points are as described below ft. and ft. west from the section corner of common to Sections 27, 28, 33, 34. 1st Point of Diversion - 713.62' W. 51.05' S. of section corner. 2nd Point of Diversion - 846.59' W. 103.73' S. of section corner.

being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 33, Tp. 3N, R. 10E, W. M., in the county of Hood River. 5. The pipe line to be 2760' in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 27, Tp. 3N, R. 10E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

Imbler by deed recorded November 4, 1897, in Book Y at page 41, Deed Records Wasco County (Book H at page 540, Deed Records Hood River County), which point is 30 rods West and 10 rods North of the South quarter corner of Section 27, Township 3 North, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian, being at the Northeast corner of that tract of land conveyed to E. B. Calkins by deed recorded May 19, 1903, in Book 36 at page 97, Deed Records Wasco County (Book C at page 428, Deed Records Hood River County); thence West along the North line of said Calkins tract of land 525 feet, more or less, to the East line of that tract of land conveyed to John R. A parcel of land lying in the Southeast Quarter of the southwest quarter of section 27, township 3 north, range 10 E. W. M. Hood River County, Oregon and being a portion of that property conveyed by that deed to M. Vilate Haskin, recorded in Book 26, page 34, of Hood River County Records of Deeds. The said parcel being that portion of said property lying south of the existing Columbia River Highway and included in a strip of land 250 feet in width, lying 175 feet southerly and 75 feet northerly of the center line of the Columbia River Highway as said highway has been relocated, which center line is described as follows:

Beginning at Engineer's center line station 1070+00, said station being 658.4 feet north and 1325.5 feet west of the south quarter corner of said section 27, thence north 72° 55' 30" east 1,000 feet to station 1080+00; the said center line crossing the west and east lines of said property approximately at station 1070+70 and station 1078+75 respectively. This is to certify that the State Engineer has approved application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from two unnamed springs

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is February 19, 1954

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 28, 1955 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1956.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1957.
