The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use
and shall not exceed 1/80 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the
stream, or its equivalent in terms of relation with other water users, from West Fork Dairy Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per
second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion
of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation
season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable regulation as may be required by the State Engineer

The priority date of this permit is March 3, 1954

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 1, 1954
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence

Complete application of the permit is required by May 1, 1954
