# To appropriate Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, South J. Bay, Inc., do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is South Branch of Yamhill River, a tributary of the Willamette River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.375 cubic feet per second. to be used from one source only

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located N 80° 04' W 312.5' ft. from the NE corner of J. J. Garrison D.L.C. No. 10

and the following limitations and conditions:

The water to be granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.175 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from South Yanhill River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state authority.

The priority date of this permit is February 17, 1954

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 20, 1954

thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 20, 1954

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before July 20, 1954
